

PUBLIC NOTICE
OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

The Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) announces the **revised** final payment parameters for the 2027 plan year for the Wisconsin Healthcare Stability Plan. Consistent with Wis. Stat. § 601.83(2), the Commissioner has adjusted the payment parameters with the goals of stabilizing or reducing premium rates, increasing participation by health insurers, improving access to health care providers and services, and mitigating the impact on premium rates of high-risk individuals participating in the individual health insurance market.

The Commissioner engaged an actuarial consulting firm to assist OCI in developing its preliminary payment parameters for plan year 2027, consistent with Wis. Stat. § 601.83. After considering the data received by insurers and the best estimates for 2027 enrollment, holding a public hearing on April 30, 2026, and considering public input, the Commissioner finalized payment parameters on May 6, 2026. OCI is now revising the final payment parameters to account for federal developments on these points, as follows:

Revised Final Payment Parameters


Attachment point: \$50,000

Co-insurance rate: 43%

Cap: \$151,500
