- *July 15, 2020: Phase I of the audit process continues. As a reminder, in June, OCI identified a subset of 58 WIHSP claims across all insurers and asked insurers to submit the list of individual claims that rolled up to the final enrollee claim amount. That list of claims data was due to OCI on July 15, 2020.
- *July 24, 2020: OCI completed review of the claims data for the Phase I audit. Items reviewed included: submission of the OCI data attestation form; submission of the confirmation page from the Attestation and Discrepancy Reporting Summary the insurers enter into with CMS after EDGE data is finalized; submission of the state affirmation of data form, submission of the OCI audit phase I form and confirmation that the totals on that form match claim totals submitted on the final WIHSP claim submission report.
- *July 24, 2020: 2019 Annual Report submitted to CCIIO and posted to the OCI website.
- *July 30, 2020: Annual Post Award Forum held...for more information see Section D of this report.
- *August 3, 2020: Insurers notified that Phase I of the audit was complete.

This was the first year OCI collected final claims data and implemented the audit process. Two key lessons learned:

- 1. Remind insurers that item three on the OCI attestation form requires them to provide us with the confirmation page from their CMS discrepancy report.
- 2. We will maintain flexibility in terms of the "proof of payment" submitted from the insurers for the Phase II audit but will need to include additional instructions, such as reminding insurers to provide the page and claim line as to where a claim is located on a remittance advice.
