(2) Exhibits for the hearing, including any prepared testimony, shall be filed with the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance no later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday November 15, 2016.

(3) Unless the administrative law judge otherwise specifically directs at the hearings, the record of both hearings will be closed following their conclusion on Wednesday November 16, 2016 except that written comments from the public will be accepted until 4:30 on November 25, 2016.

(4) The record of the public hearing scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on November 16, 2016 will be admitted into the record of the class 1 contested case hearing and the record of class 1 contested case hearing will be made part of the record of the public hearing.

(5) The class 1 contested case hearing and the public hearing will be held at the times and place described in the notice of hearing.

(6) No motion to allow discovery under s. Ins 5.53, Wis. Adm. Code has been received and no discovery will be allowed.
