PY 2021 WIHSP Audit

The OCI WIHSP audit, entailing OCI review of final WIHSP claim reports submitted in May of each year, was completed at the end of September. The final WIHSP claim report is the basis for WIHSP payment to insurers. There are two phases to the audit process. During phase 1, the OCI Administrator reviews individual claim amounts that roll up to the final WIHSP claim amount reported for a subset of enrollees. Generally, 60 total claim samples across all insurers are reviewed. The number of enrollee claims reviewed per insurer depends on each insurer's WIHSP claim volume. Those with more claims have more enrollee claims reviewed. Phase I was completed in early July. In Phase II, OCI requests proof of payment for claims reviewed under Phase I. In total, insurers submitted proof of payment documentation for 130 claims. There were no issues discovered during the audit.

PY 2021 Payment to Insurers

Insurer payments were disbursed on July 8, 2022. The total payment amount was \$202,811,341.37. The state statutory deadline for payment is August 15th of the year following the applicable benefit year.

1332 Waiver Extension Application

On August 5, 2022, OCI submitted an application to extend the 1332 Waiver for five years, through 2028. HHS sent a letter of preliminary completeness on September 2, 2022.

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Insurer Q2 Reports

Insurers submitted their Q2 reports August 15th. The aggregated Q2 total is \$73,642,017.81.

Federal Pass-Through Report

A data call was sent to insurers on August 10th and was due back on August 19th. Data collected was used to inform the federal pass-through report due September 23rd. OCI submitted the report on September 22, 2022.

PI/PD & AOR

On August 26th, an attempt was made to update the AOR and PI/PD in grant solutions. The following email was sent to CMS on 8/26 explaining the attempt.

Good afternoon.

I'm e-mailing to update you on the efforts made to modify the PI/PD and AOR in grantsolutions.

I entered documents related to modifying the PI/PD to me several weeks back. Today I went into the system to update the AOR. After clicking the option for a "new amendment" the system requires you to choose the type of amendment. There is an option related to changing the PI/PD but there isn't one related to AOR. So, I chose PI/PD and uploaded documents related to changing the AOR to our Deputy Commissioner Rachel Cissne Carabell. However, I don't know if that overrides the information previously entered designating me at the PI/PD.

If you need anything further from us on this, please let me know. If the system has Rachel for both PI/PD and AOR at this point, that is ok. The main thing is that both Megan and Sue no longer work for OCI and shouldn't be listed.
